Strengthening How Leaders are Experienced When it Matters Most

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The Problem

Some of your strongest leaders are being underestimated in critical moments. Not because they lack capability, but because how they show up does not consistently reflect the quality of their thinking. In board settings, this appears in subtle but consequential ways:

- Clear thinking that sounds incomplete.
- Recommendations that lack visible ownership.
- Operational detail that dilutes strategic intent.
- Confidence that shifts under pressure.
